

Section 4 Example Using Career Assessment

On September 9, 2013, [REDACTED] participated in Career Assessment at EHOVE Career Center. Career Assessment is a series of assessments that offer an opportunity to explore interest areas and aptitudes for potential future careers. The assessment includes an interest inventory, hands-on assessment, Learning Assessment Program (LAPs) which assess a student's skill level in the areas of math, communication, and problem-solving as it relates to specific skill areas.

The results of the interest inventory indicate that [REDACTED] shows the highest level of interest in the area of Hospitality, Tourism & Recreation. This means the student demonstrates an interest in catering to the personal wishes and needs of others so that they may enjoy a clean environment, good food and drink, comfortable lodging away from home, and recreation. For the hands-on portion of Career Assessment, [REDACTED] had to setup a four-place restaurant cover and to take orders, which included the taking down on a guest check of five individual orders for food, on a simulated Point of Sales system. For both work samples, he scored in the top 10% for quality of work. His time to complete the tasks was rated in the lower one third of the population. [REDACTED]'s Learning Assessment Programs show that he experienced a high level of success in the areas of: Restaurant Vocabulary- General Vocabulary, Technical Vocabulary 80%, Restaurant Math- Whole Numbers 91%, and Health Department Codes- Following Written Instructions, Literal Comprehension 100%. Areas he needs to improve upon are: Food Service Abbreviations- Following Oral Instructions, Abbreviations 50%.

The Career Assessment indicated the [REDACTED]'s career goal of cooking would be appropriate if he continues to take and pass classes in the Ohio Core Curriculum and he decreases his amount of days absent. B
