How do I schedule Career Assessment?

There are several different ways to get assessed. You may contact your teacher, case manager, or work study coordinator. Or you may e-mail the Career Assessment Specialist directly at mpeters@ehove.net.

****Remember, in order to come, you need a signed permission slip from your parent. ****

Does participating in Career Assessment mean I have to go to EHOVE?

No. Participating in Career Assessment does not mean you have to attend EHOVE. Career Assessment looks at all career fields that may suit your interests and abilities, not just the programs that EHOVE offers.

How will I know where to go?

Your teacher and/or work study coordinator will let you know the date of your assessment, where you need to be, and at what time.

How long does it last?

Career Assessment will last for approximately half of your school day. This could be from three to three and a half hours long.

When will I get to go to EHOVE Career Center?

EHOVE Career Center has three days (November 11-13) in which sophomores from the area schools are scheduled to visit; it's called Sophomore Orientation. Each school has one specific day designated for their visit. In order to find out which day your school is scheduled to visit, you can talk to your guidance counselor or work study coordinator. On this day, you pick three career and technical programs in which you might be interested in pursuing and you spend time getting to tour the lab, talking to the teacher, and meeting current students. EHOVE Career Center has an Open House on the evening of November 13th, 2014. On this night, you can bring your family to tour the facilities and meet the teachers.
