The Board approved 50-100 Hour Supplemental Contracts for Community & Promotional Activities, Equipment Repair, Media Center Prep and Transportation Fleet.

The Board reviewed the Course of Study for the Green Science Technology Program for possible adoption in June.

The Board approved the Master Teacher Program as proposed by the LPDC (Local Professional Development Committee) and outlined in the Ohio Standards for the Teaching Profession.

The Board entered into agreement with the Erie County Sheriff to provide Police Services (School Resource Officer) for the 2010-2011 school year. (August 24, 2010 - May 27, 2011)

The Board accepted donations and approved Professional Leaves.

The Board joined the Northwestern Ohio Educational Research Council, Inc. (NWOERC) for the 2010-2011 school year at a cost of \$200. (\$25 increase from 2009-2010)

The Board renewed the Treasurer's OASBO (Ohio Association of School Board Officials) Membership for 2010-2011 and Board Liability Insurance for July 2, 1020 through June 30, 2011 with Ohio School Plan.

The Board re-approved a Resolution To Issue Energy Conservation Notes in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000, an increase from the \$1,800,000 approved in April.
