- PFLAG will award an annual scholarship in the sum of \$250.00
- Payment of award will be made directly to the student upon proof of enrollment
- References are required from two people (other than relatives) that know you in the community (forms provided)
- The student must be enrolled as a full time student. The College, University, or Adult Education Center definition of "full time student" is acceptable.
- The term of the Scholarship is one (1) academic year. Prior recipients are invited to apply for a second year provided they meet all eligibility requirements.
- Deadline for application: postmarked prior to midnight of **April 10, 2010**. No applications will be considered after that date. No exceptions.
- The application must be signed and filled out completely and presented with all the required documentation as requested.
